## CARE AFTER CHEMICAL TREATMENT

Your warts have been treated chemically. Sometimes the chemical causes a blister to form. This blister helps to peel away the root of the wart.

1. Remove the Band Aid after 6 hours and wash the chemically treated area with soap and water.
2. If a blister forms and is painful, you may pop it with a sterile needle.
3. You may apply plain Vaseline twice daily to the blistered area to prevent secondary infection.

REMEMBER: It takes approximately 3-4 weeks for new skin to form and the area to heal completely.
