WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS ELECTRODESSICATION

The procedure just performed was the destruction of a skin lesion by Electrocautery. The area may be pink for several days / weeks after treatment. The treated area may develop a yellow center, it is not pus, it is granulation tissue and is normal. The area will look infected, but almost never is.

On occasion, the skin may be lighter or darker than normal. Sometimes a thickened scar may occur.

Other Instructions:

- Remove Band Aid / Dressing after 24-48 hours
- Area may be gently washed and patted dry
- Apply plain Vaseline to the area twice daily until healed
- If the area is not draining, you may leave it open to the air or you cover it
- If the wound is in an area where clothing may irritate it, cover with a Band Aid / Dressing and Vaseline until healed
- If the area becomes inflamed, hot to the touch, or has excessive drainage, or if you experience fever or extreme discomfort, please call the office
